The policy ensures alignment with the UAE National Agenda priorities, ADEK requirements, and Cognia Performance Standards, while supporting students' holistic growth and preparing them for success in higher education and global citizenship. To ensure curriculum coverage and delivery is consistent, challenging, and culturally responsive.

Scope

This policy applies to:

- All academic and non-academic programs (KG-Grade 12).
- All teaching and learning activities, assessments, and co-curricular programsll staff, faculty, and administrators are responsible for curriculum planning and delivery.

Curriculum Design

- At Royal American School, we offer an adaptive, rigorous, and cohesive curriculum that is rooted in a clear rationale, aligning with our identity as an American International School and the UAE's National Vision.
- Our comprehensive curriculum is broad and balanced, addressing the diverse needs of each child. It is innovative, relevant, and tailored to meet the individual needs of all learners through varied experiences that enhance their knowledge, understanding, and skills across subject areas.
- The culturally responsive curriculum is designed to nurture critical thinking, communication, social, research, and self-management skills, fostering lifelong independent learners.
- ➤ We emphasize conceptual and cross-curricular connections, ensuring the practical application of knowledge in real-world scenarios and promoting deeper understanding across disciplines.
- Our curriculum prepares students for success in the next grade level and beyond, with regular horizontal and vertical reviews to support their continuous progress, while also aligning with local and national priorities.

Curriculum Design

- 1. Core Instructional Model: RAS delivers an American curriculum based on:
 - Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for English Language Arts and Mathematics.
 - Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) for science.
 - AERO Standards (American Education Reaches Out) for Social Studies and other subjects, where applicable.
 - A standards-based scope and sequence for all other subjects.
- 2. Mandatory ADEK Subjects: in full compliance with ADEK regulations, the following subjects are mandatory for all eligible students:
 - Arabic Language: Provided for all students (Arabic speakers and non-Arabic speakers) as per the prescribed time allocation and MOE/ADEK guidelines.
 - Islamic Studies: Provided for all Muslim students as per the prescribed time allocation and MOE/ADEK guidelines.
 - UAE Social Studies / Moral Education: Integrated into the curriculum for all grade levels to foster an understanding and appreciation of UAE heritage, culture, values, and national identity.
- 3. Curriculum Breadth: The curriculum at RAS includes:

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- o Core Subjects: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies.
- Specialist Subjects: Arabic Language, Islamic Studies, Physical Education, Art, Music, Technology, and Library Skills.

- STEM/STEAM Education: Integrated projects that combine Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics.

- Digital Literacy: Responsible and effective use of technology for learning.
- Wellbeing: Programs that support students' social and emotional health

CURRICULUM ADAPTATION

Additionally, a wide range of extracurricular activities enhances and extends learning in different contexts, sparking curiosity, enjoyment, and active participation within a broader community

Curriculum Justification

Early Years: KG1 & KG2

Our holistic, hands-on, and individualized curriculum is based on common core CCSS and NGCC Standards. Curriculum is modified to include links to UAE culture and heritage. The curriculum is designed to build children's confidence, creativity, and critical thinking skills through hands-on, project-based investigations. The units and lessons promote discovery and inquiry with opportunities for children to develop their academic and social-emotional skills with rich, interactive investigations of relevant and interesting topics both in the classroom and beyond. Teachers utilize student interests and questions to modify the curriculum to support high levels of student engagement and support students in meeting their own personal and academic goals. The curriculum is enhanced by special events, trips, and activities.

Elementary - Grades 1-5

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Our transdisciplinary, inquiry-based, and conceptual curriculum is based on common core, NGSS and MoE Standards. Curriculum is modified to include links to UAE culture and heritage. The curriculum provides broad and balanced lessons across subject areas and is designed to develop the foundational skills of reading, writing, and math while teaching students how to apply these skills to access knowledge across the curriculum. The student-centered approach takes into consideration students' prior learning, needs, interests, and wonderings in order to deliver engaging and challenging lessons for all students. Students are expected to become more independent learners, taking responsibility for their own learning through the development of thinking, communication, social, research, and self-management skills. Our curriculum provides opportunities for learning through creative, physical, and practical experiences that develop students' knowledge, skills, and understandings. There are also opportunities for students to learn beyond the classroom through special events, trips, and activities.

Middle School - Grades 6-8

Our comprehensive, inclusive, and well-rounded curriculum is grounded in the common core, NGSS and MoE Standards, while also incorporating connections to UAE culture and heritage. In Middle School, students are introduced to a wide range of subjects designed to help them discover their strengths, interests, and aspirations, while also preparing them for various high school pathways. Teachers consider the unique needs, interests, and goals of each student, tailoring the curriculum to ensure it is both engaging and challenging for all learners. The curriculum offers opportunities for hands-on, creative, and physical learning experiences that enhance students' knowledge, skills, and understanding. Throughout the program, students participate in cross-curricular and conceptual learning within meaningful and engaging contexts. A key focus is on fostering independent learning, emphasizing the development of critical thinking, communication, social, research, and self-management skills. Additionally, students have the chance to expand their learning beyond the classroom through special events, field trips, lectures, and activities

High School - Grades 9-12

- Our broad, balanced, and rigorous American curriculum is based on common core, NGSS Standards, with modifications to incorporate connections to UAE culture and heritage, The curriculum is designed to offer students choice and flexibility, supporting their academic and personal goals for high school, university, and beyond. Course development and recommended pathways ensure smooth progression of learning throughout the high school years. The curriculum includes a variety of creative, physical, and practical experiences, both inside and outside the classroom, aimed at strengthening students' knowledge, skills, and understanding. Throughout the program, students engage in cross-curricular learning within meaningful and engaging contexts, while developing independent learning through the enhancement of critical thinking, communication, social, research, and self-management skills.
- ➤ Royal American School's Earth & Space Science program is designed to align with the UAE National Space Program and Vision 2031, building students' knowledge in astronomy, planetary science, satellites, and climate science. It emphasizes critical thinking, hands-on experiments, and space-related projects, while encouraging careers in aerospace, engineering, and science. The curriculum covers Earth systems and sustainability, space exploration, UAE space missions, satellite and aerospace technology, and student-led research and innovation projects, including participation in competitions and global science fairs.
- ➤ To provide additional challenge and rigor to students within the American High School Track, Advanced Placement (AP) courses are available to students. AP courses enable willing and academically prepared students to pursue college-level studies while still in high school. They are modeled after comparable introductory level university courses and culminate in a standardized college-level assessment or AP Exam. The successful completion of AP classes provides students with improved prospects for college admission and success. The school offers four subjects in AP (Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics AB & BC, Physics)

Curriculum review cycle and development

The ongoing and systematic review of the curriculum is crucial for student success. Throughout the year, teachers engage in reflective practices to assess the effectiveness and alignment of our curriculum both vertically and horizontally. Additionally, we are committed to conducting a thorough and detailed review of each subject area's curriculum on a regular basis to ensure that our students receive the highest quality education. All members of the teaching and leadership teams should be actively involved in the review, development, implementation, refinement, and evaluation of the curriculum. The stages of the RAS Curriculum Review Cycle are as follows:

1. Review Cycle

The curriculum undergoes a formal review on an annual basis led by the Academic Leadership Team and department heads. This review considers:

- Student achievement data.
- Teacher feedback.
- Updates to ADEK and home country standards.
- o Emerging educational research and best practices.

2. Professional Development

Ongoing professional development is provided to ensure all teaching staff are effectively implementing the curriculum and are trained in relevant pedagogical approaches and ADEK expectations.

Roles and Responsibilities

- School Principal / Head of Academics: Overall responsibility for curriculum implementation and compliance.
- Heads of Department / Curriculum Coordinators: Lead the development, mapping, and review of their subject areas.
- Teachers: Responsible for the daily implementation of the curriculum, lesson planning, and assessment.

Parental and Community Involvement

RAS believes in a strong partnership with parents and the community. We communicate our curriculum through:

- o Parent orientation sessions.
- School website and handbook.
- o Curriculum newsletters and workshops.
- Inviting community members to share expertise related to UAE culture and other learning areas.
